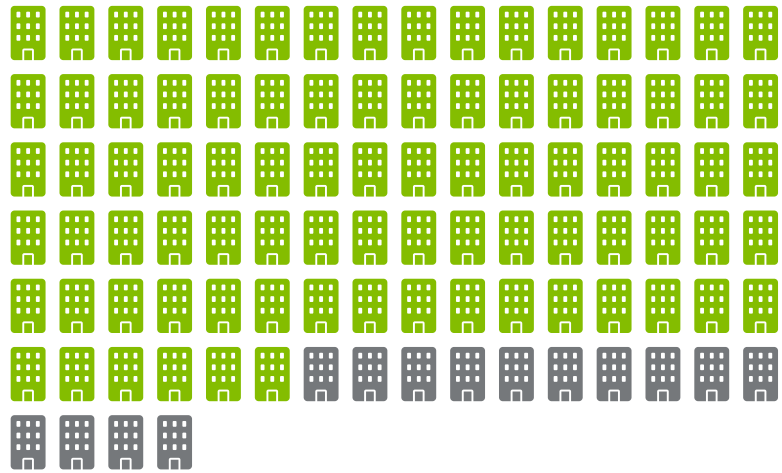

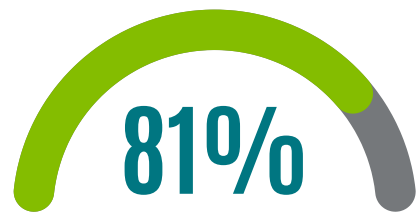
Experiences of Canadian nonprofits reported in the second quarter of 2021



Eighty-six percent of community nonprofits reported being optimistic about the next 12 months.

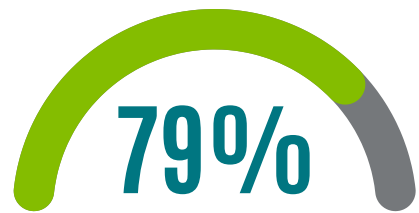
STAYING IN BUSINESS

Organizations expect to be able to continue operating 6+ months

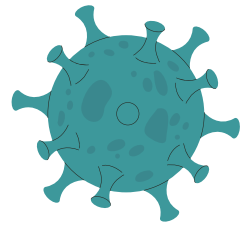


KEEPING EMPLOYEES

Used virtual services to reach NEW clients

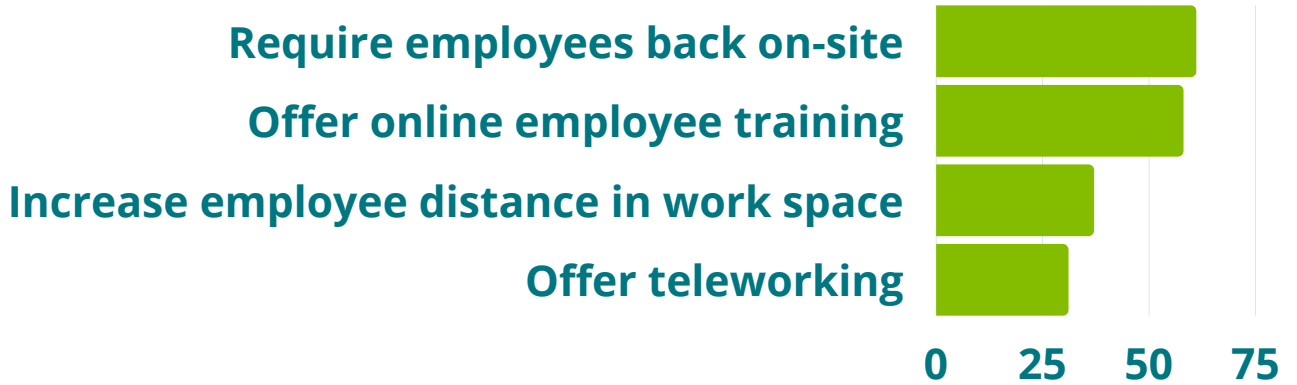


USED COVID-19 FUNDS
