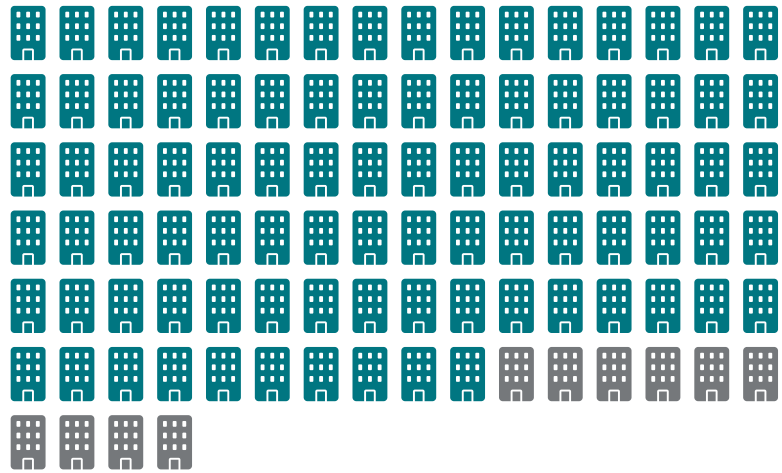

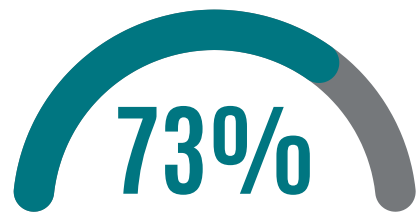
Experiences of Canadian community nonprofits reported in the third quarter of 2021



Ninety percent of community nonprofits reported being optimistic about the next 12 months.

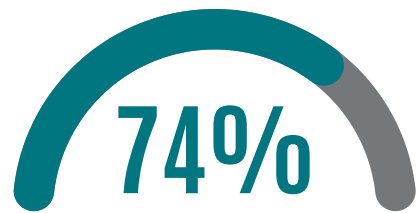
STAYING IN BUSINESS

Organizations expect to be able to continue operating 6+ months



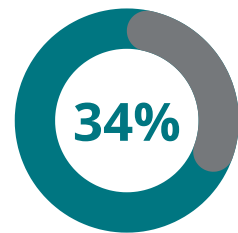
KEEPING EMPLOYEES

Organizations expect to be able to continue to operate 6+ months without layoffs



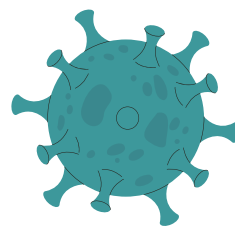
TOP REPORTED OBSTACLE?
