

Post-secondary students lived in higher socio-economic status neighbourhoods than non-students

- Youth enrolled in post-secondary institutions were more likely to be living in higher socio-economic status neighbourhoods than youth not enrolled.
- Among youth participating in the post-secondary education system, 27% were living in the highest socio-economic status neighbourhoods, compared with 18% in the lowest.
