

Hospital services received varied with educational achievement

- In Alberta in 2008/09, there were 7,453 hospitalizations of youth 12 to 20 years old who were registered in the education system.
- Surgery or procedure was the most common type of hospital service for hospitalizations of youth meeting or above educational expectations (45% of hospitalizations) while general medicine hospitalizations were most common for youth performing below expectations (35%).
- Pregnancy-related and psychiatric hospitalizations were more common among hospitalizations of youth performing below expectations than among hospitalizations of youth meeting or achieving above expectations.
